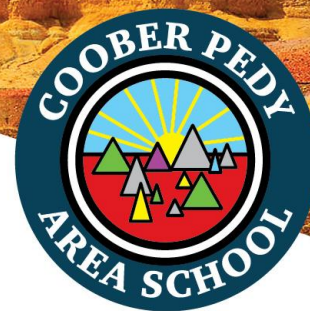

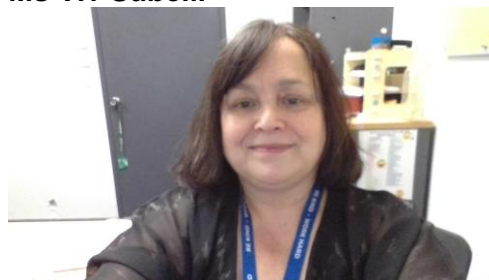

**Ms Viv Subelli**



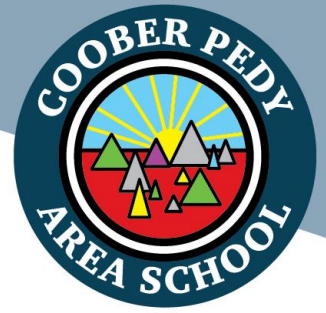

In English, the Year 7/8s are working on Grammar, Reading Comprehension, and some individual projects. Below are some work samples from our students:

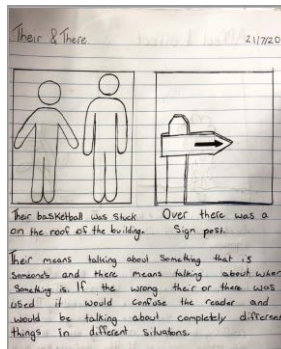
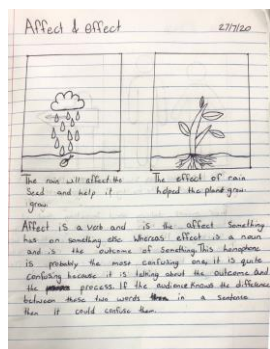

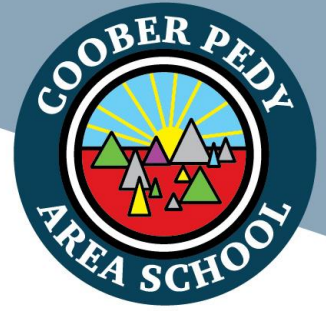
### JUNIOR PRIMARY- LITERACY

## COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS UPDATE

We have updated our site-specific measures and precautions as follows:

School assemblies commenced from Friday, 3<sup>rd</sup> July, 2020 and will continue until further notice.

Parents/caregivers and community members attending assemblies and school events will be supported to observe social distancing protocols.

Parents/caregivers and approved visitors are allowed into classes/learning areas until further notice. While in these learning areas, they are required to maintain social distancing and use the hand sanitisers provided.

Cooking lessons will continue with risk assessments completed and approved. The food produced from the cooking lessons can be consumed on site provided they are dished out into individual containers and students eat them individually (not more than one student eating from the same food container)

After school activities onsite (particularly in the gym) have commenced with the appropriate risk assessment completed, approved and complied with.

Our students will continue to play in designated areas during recess and lunch.

We look to your co-operation and support with this and we will update you all should there be any changes.
